Important Information

(Broad speciality candidates NEET PG 2021)
(Round 2)

Owing to on-going joining (through DMHS, Rajasthan) by round 1 allotted in-service candidates at their allotted place of SR posting by 25.10.2025 and in continuation to the notification dated 08.10.2025 all concerned Broad speciality In-service as well as Non-service candidates (NEET PG 2021) are required to note the following in respect of on-going round 2 allotment process:

1. Choices filled by the candidate in Round 1 will not be considered for Round 2 allotment. Choice filling is mandatory. **Filled choices are editable multiple times.** Refer round 2 provisional merit lists dated 16.10.2025.
2. Irrespective of whether a seat in a college/branch is vacant or not, candidates participating in round 2 must fill choices keeping in view the **virtual vacancies** that may arise due to upgradation of a joined candidate of round 1.
3. Round 1 joined candidate who is not willing to upgrade and wishes to retain his/her round 1 joined seat need not fill choices in Round 2.
4. A **non-service candidate holding a seat** (round 1 joined candidate) who is willing to upgrade in round 2 must **fill the desired choices for upgradation** (need not fill all the available choices).
5. A **non-service candidate not holding any seat** must **fill ALL the choices available** to him/her according to his/her eligibility.
6. **In-service candidate holding a seat** (round 1 joined candidate) who is willing to upgrade in round 2 must **fill the desired choices for upgradation** (need not fill all the available choices).
7. **In-service candidate not holding any seat OR not intending to join round 1 allotted seat by 25.10.2025** and willing to participate in round 2 may **fill the desired choices** (need not fill ALL the available choices).
8. Subsequently, **Round 2 provisional seat matrix** will be prepared on the basis of joining status by round 1 allotted candidates (subsequent to getting relieved by DMHS) and will be made available at the website.
9. Allotment information shall be made available at the website in due course.

The concerned candidates are advised to visit the website regularly for updates and other relevant information.
