**Guidelines for participating in Round 2 of the allotment process  
(Broad speciality, Non-service, In-service)**

1. For round 2 of the allotment process, registration/on-line application form will be opened at the website for candidates who could not register earlier / who could not complete their registration in round 1.
2. All candidates who are holding a SR seat (round 1 allotted and joined candidates) are eligible to participate in round 2 allotment process.
3. All candidates who are not holding a SR seat (including round 1 allotted and not-joined candidates) are eligible to participate in round 2 allotment process.
4. NEET PG 2022 candidates passing PG course from a private college and verified by DMHS as in-service during Rajasthan State NEET PG Counseling 2022 are eligible to participate in round 2 of the allotment process.
5. All candidates who have not been allotted a seat in round 1 are eligible to participate in round 2 of the allotment process.
6. Mandatory Choice filling of the colleges on-line will be activated at the website for eligible candidates who wish to participate in round 2 of the allotment process.
7. All the candidates who wish to participate (for upgradation / fresh allotment in round 2), are required to fill **FRESH CHOICES**.
8. The earlier allotted seat of all candidates who do not fill fresh choices in round 2 and are holding a seat (round 1 allotted and joined candidates) will be retained as such.
9. If a round 1 candidate not holding a seat does not fill fresh choices in round 2 will not be considered in round 2 of the allotment process.
10. Round 1 allotted college, if any to a candidate, will automatically be a part of the choices for round 2. In case, no other college is allotted to such a candidate during round 2, the round 1 allotted college will be retained as such for round 2 also.
